

COMMON CONDITIONAL SENTENCES

Type of Condition

Protasis (“If . . .”)

Apodosis (“then . . .”)

1. Real

$\epsilon\acute{\iota}$ + indicative mood verb

Indicative mood verb or alternative

2. Hypothetical

$\epsilon\acute{\iota}\nu$ + subjunctive mood verb

Indicative mood verb or alternative

3. Unreal

$\epsilon\acute{\iota}$ + past tense indicative mood verb

Past tense indicative mood verb (usu. + $\epsilon\acute{\iota}\nu$)
